

## **PROHIBITED / HAZARDOUS CARGO LIST**

The following common household items have been defined as hazardous and / or prohibited materials by the U.S. Secretary of Transportation and are not accepted under any circumstances for international freight:

### **COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS**

- Alcohol (Rubbing)
- Lubricants (Motor Oils)

### **CORROSIVES**

- Acids
- Anti-Freeze Compounds
- Batteries (wet or dry)
- Bleach
- Drain Cleaner / Oven Cleaner
- Photographic acids used in developing film
- Water purifying agents used in swimming pools

### **EXPLOSIVES**

- Fireworks / Ammunition / Gun Powder
- Flash Bulbs
- Print toner cartridges and electronic equipment with lithium batteries (TSA prohibited for airfreight)
- Small Arms Ammunition

### **FLAMMABLES**

- Butane / Propane / Gasoline
- Charcoal Briquettes
- Lighter Fluid
- Matches
- Paint or Varnish
- Paint or Varnish Removers / Thinner
- Petrol-Chemical Base Garden Sprays
- Signal Flares
- Wood Oil Stains

### **COMPRESSED GASES**

- Aerosol Cans
- Fire Extinguishers
- Scuba Diving Tanks

### **LIVE PLANTS, SEEDS, FRESH FRUITS, OR FLOWERS**
