- -Batteries (wet or dry)
- -Bleach
- -Drain Cleaner / Oven Cleaner
- -Photographic acids used in developing film
- -Water purifying agents used in swimming pools

EXPLOSIVES

- -Fireworks / Ammunition / Gun Powder
- -Flash Bulbs
- -Print toner cartridges and electronic equipment with lithium batteries (TSA prohibited for airfreight)
- -Small Arms Ammunition

FLAMMABLES

- -Butane / Propane / Gasoline
- -Charcoal Briquettes
- -Lighter Fluid
- -Matches
- -Paint or Varnish
- -Paint or Varnish Removers / Thinner
- -Petrol-Chemical Base Garden Sprays
- -Signal Flares
- -Wood Oil Stains

COMPRESSED GASES

- -Aerosol Cans
- -Fire Extinguishers
- -Scuba Diving Tanks
